

CAL Launches Non-Stop Service between JFK and AIA

Kingstown, ST. VINCENT: Caribbean Airlines (CAL) officially launched its non-stop service between the John F Kennedy International Airport (JFK) in New York and the Argyle International Airport (AIA) today at the Beachcombers Hotel in Villa.



Sales Executive for the Eastern Caribbean Veena Rattan-King says St Vincent and the Grenadines (SVG) is an important partner for CAL. She said: "At Caribbean Airlines we are in the business of connecting people and this service between John F Kennedy International Airport in New York and Argyle International Airport (AIA) will provide more travel options between the Eastern Caribbean and North America."

The service, which begins on Wednesday, March 14, National Heroes' Day, will feature weekly non-stop flights every Wednesday.
