



Elective at Milton Cato Memorial Hospital

Please be advised that medical students who have been chosen to undertake an elective at Milton Cato do not need work permits or a letter from an overseas mission or consular post, but they do require a letter of acceptance from the Hospital. They will also need to meet the requirements for entry to SVG.

General Entry Requirements for Visitors

All visitors to Saint Vincent and the Grenadines (SVG) should be in possession of a passport valid for the period of their intended stay in addition to the following:

- a return ticket to the country of origin or other destination where there is 'landed' status;
- sufficient funds for the duration of the visit;
- evidence of accommodation arrangements for the period of stay.

The SVG Immigration Authority will determine the length of stay.

Entry Visas

Persons travelling on the following passports must also be in possession of an Entry Visa before entering St Vincent and the Grenadines:

Afghanistan, Dominican Republic, Haiti, Iran, Iraq, Lebanon, Nigeria, People's Republic of China (PRC), Syria
